Is a power bank allowed in a carry-on?

Yes, it's allowed in your carry-on as it falls below the 100 Wh limit. Similarly, if you have a 20,000 mAh portable charger, it would be approximately 74 Wh. This is also within the allowed range for carry-on luggage.  $\text{Watt-hours} = (20,000 \text{ mAh} \times 3.7 \text{ V}) / 1000 = 74 \text{ Wh}$  Now, let's consider a 50,000 mAh power bank:
