What is the telecommunication system in the Central African Republic?

Telecommunications in the Central African Republic includes radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet as well as the postal system. Persistent conflict has hampered telecommunication and media development in the Central African Republic.

How has conflict impacted telecommunication and media development in Central African Republic?

Persistent conflict has hampered telecommunication and media development in the Central African Republic. There are active television services, radio stations, internet service providers, and mobile phone carriers. Radio is the most-popular communications medium.

Are there government restrictions on Internet access in Central Africa?

There are no government restrictions on access to the Internet or credible reports that the government monitors e-mail or Internet chat rooms without judicial oversight. More than five million websites (except for Spotify was not available in that country) are available/accessible in the Central African Republic.

What radio stations are in Bangui?

In Bangui, UN-sponsored Radio Ndeke Luka ("bird of luck") provides balanced output, and rebroadcasts international news programming. Other radio and TV stations are run by the state-run Radiodiffusion-Télévision Centrafricaine and provide little coverage of the political opposition.
