What is a base station Radio?

A base (or fixed) station radio also contains a transmitter and a receiver. The radio is powered by an external electrical system (typically 110 V ac) and is connected to an antenna located tens to hundreds of feet away, typically on top of a building or on a tower.

What RF band does a public safety radio use?

Common radio messages are transmitted over the RF band between 0.05 MHz and 900 MHz. Most public safety communications radios (portable, mobile, base station, and repeaters) transmit frequencies between 30 MHz and 900 MHz which are dedicated to public service use.

Why is a radio more effective than a portable radio?

Because of the higher transmitter power and external antenna, the effective communication range is greater than that of a portable radio, especially if a repeater is not used.

Why is a trunked radio system better than a conventional radio system?

Because the computer selects the channel and monitors the repeater before transmitting, the trunked radio system is more technically complex than the conventional system. Since it appears to be simpler and faster to use, it may be considered more efficient.

What are the disadvantages of a conventional radio system?

Disadvantages to conventional radio systems include user accessibility delays when a channel is being utilized by other users, and security concerns because of the ease of "eavesdropping" on potentially sensitive communications by the public or media equipped with scanner radios.

What are the different types of communication systems?

The technologies are discussed in section 2.1, types of equipment are presented in section 2.2, accessories are discussed in section 2.3, and enhancements are discussed in section 2.4. For practical purposes, a communication system can be considered to be "wired" or "wireless" (e.g., conventional telephone, radio communications, etc.).
